Although Justice Isaccs rejected your argument even that of the question of authority of The NEC if you read Article: 87 Constitution of The Bahamas unless the majority , a min. of seven members, was present there is not a quorum. Cabinet comprises of 15 members .

I would request substantiation from The Cabinet Secretary as to the attendance specifically when these matters were discussed.

Obviously the Government has in their favour as they will argue that irrespective of everything Cabinet did eventual discuss and vote on the matter .

To my knowledge the NEC does not include all members of Cabinet but a select group – I would ask for which Minister comprises the NEC?
